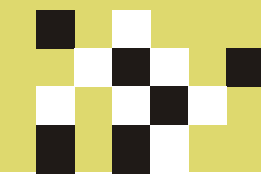

Prize Moeny earned by Foreign players is taxed @11.2% as per Indian Law

- The tournament will be conducted as per the FIDE LAWS of Chess
- In case of tie prize money will be shared
- Final placings will be as per progressive system in the event of a tie
- Any player can win only one prize
- Cell phones are not allowed inside the tournament hall
- All the participants must be registered players of AICF
- Players are requested to cooperate with the Security in the hall

- Violation of the dress code by any player will attract penalty
